Event Reports

Round 5 BCC Championship 1st June.

In the ladies Renee Larter also driving the Team Skyline topped the ladies with Amy Seyfort being the best placed junior lady. Andrew Daniel had his maiden win being 1st junior and 8th outright.

In the motorkhana the seniors once again showed the juniors how to do it taking the top 3 places for the second month in a row. Peter Panozzo held off Paul Wells to take the win with Peter Thomas 3rd. Corey Talbot topped the juniors in 4th outright ahead of Craig Thomas with Jack Jelbart in 6th outright. Casey Williamson was the best placed lady ahead of Ashley Astbury and Jessica Farrar.

2008 Phil Doherty BCC Junior Challenge 15th June.

17 juniors came out to play in ideal track and weather conditions. Competitors were kept on their toes with 12 tests run and included was the Hopkirk with its reversing section to really test the skills on show.

Craig Thomas (class A) had a slow start but worked his way to the front with smooth clean runs all day to take the win by 8 seconds over Corey Talbot (class B) who was another driver to keep the penalty sheet clean. Luke Farrar (class B) followed in third by over 10 seconds so his 2 penalties didn't cost him in the end. The top placed class A was Matt Coombs in 7th. Best placed lady was Natasha Gill-Symons in 10th. One of the drives for the day was Brayden Carss in his 200B Datsun competing in his first year took out the rookie class in 6th outright.
