- Motorsport Australia NASCAR Esports Championship Qualifying Series:
 With Motorsport Australia teaming up with the Australian NASCAR eSeries the Championship has now been locked in for 2025. The 8 Qualifying races will be held starting September and ending in December. The best of your 7 rounds contribute to the final points total.
- Maxwell Group Gold City 450.
 This will be the fourth round of the Motorsport Australia Off Road Championship and is being held on a varied course in Charters Towers, Queensland. The course is designed to challenge the teams providing both a mix of high speed and technical sections. The final round of the Championship is to be held in Kalgoorlie.
- The Scuderia Ferrari Driver Academy (FDA) Asia Pacific and Oceania selection Program.
 This program is open to drivers aged from 14 to 17 years from the Asia Pacific and Oceania regions.
 The scouts from FDA will be in attendance at Sepang International Circuit to watch 25 teenagers show their skills behind the wheel of their Tatuus Formula 4 Generation 2 cars.
- 2024 Motorsport Australia Hill Climb Championship.
 In October the Gippsland Car Club will hold one of the best hill climbs. The event will be held over the last weekend in October at the famous Bryant Park. This will be the first time back on this track since 2018.
- 2024 Motorsport Australia Speed and Auto Test Championship.
 This championship has 4 events, each showcasing their respective disciplines. The first event being the Motorsport Australia Hill Climb being held in October.


